A resolution to approve the Second Amendment to a grant contract to construct affordable housing between The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission, and Living Development Concepts, Inc.

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County ("Metro"), acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission ("Commission"), previously entered into a grant contract with Living Development Concepts, Inc., for the express purpose of constructing affordable housing approved by RS2022-1857; and,

WHEREAS, RS2022-1857 granted four properties owned by Metro to Living Development Concepts, Inc., for the express purpose of constructing affordable housing; and,

WHEREAS, Metro, acting by and through the Commission, previously executed a First Amendment to the grant contract, which extended the term of the contract to 36 months, and was approved by RS2024-710; and,

WHEREAS, the property located at 919 43rd Avenue North was deemed not feasible for construction due to significant site issues, which caused Living Development Concepts Inc., to return the property to Metro and decrease the grant amount due to a reduced number of overall units being constructed; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend section B.1 of this grant contract by extending the term of the contract to 48 months, section C.2 to reduce the maximum grant amount to \$395,150.77, and replace Attachment A to the grant contract, a copy of which amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that the amendment to the grant contract be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That this Second Amendment to the grant contract for constructing affordable housing between The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Housing Trust Fund Commission, and Living Development Concepts, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

AMENDMENT #2 TO GRANT CONTRACT RS2022-1857 BETWEEN

THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON

COUNTY

BY AND THROUGH THE METROPOLITAN HOUSING TRUST FUND COMMISSION

AND

LIVING DEVELOPMENT CONCEPTS, INC.

This contract amendment is entered into by and between THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE METROPOLITAN HOUSING TRUST FUND COMMISSION, a municipal corporation of the State of Tennessee (hereinafter referred to as "Metro") and LIVING DEVELOPMENT CONCEPTS, INC (hereinafter referred to as "Recipient"). It is mutually understood and agreed by and between said undersigned contracting parties that the subject Grant Contract approved is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Delete 919 43rd Ave. N. from the list of properties included in the introductory paragraph.
- 2. Delete \$750,000 in the last sentence of Grant Contract section A.3 and replace with \$395,150.77.
- 3. Grant Contract section B.1 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - **B.1.** Grant Contract Term. The term of this Grant shall be from execution of the grant agreement until Project completion, but in no way greater than 48 months from the execution of the grant agreement. Metro shall have no obligation for services rendered by the Recipient which are not performed within this term.
- 4. Grant Contract section C.1. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - C.1. Maximum liability under this Grant Contract shall not exceed Three Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand One Hundred Fifty Dollars and Seventy-Seven Cents (\$395,150.77).

5. Attachment A is deleted in its entirety and replaced with a new Attachment A.

The remaining provisions of the Contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
