RE: NOTICE OF EAST BANK DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY VACANCIES

Notice is hereby given of two vacancies on the East Bank Development Authority of the Metropolitan Government, which pursuant to Chapter 68 of the Private Acts of 2024, and Ordinance No. BL2024-428, are to be filled by Metropolitan Council election. These vacancies are the result of the establishment of the East Bank Development Authority by the ratification and passage of Ordinance No. BL2024-428 on August 20, 2024. The two vacancies of the East Bank Development Authority filled by the Metropolitan Council serve initial terms with the following expiration dates: one (1) member's term expires on June 30, 2026, and one (1) member's term expires on June 30, 2027. After initial terms, members of the East Bank Development Authority serve terms lasting four years. An authority member is eligible for reappointment and may serve a maximum of two full terms in addition to the initial term.

The procedure for filling vacancies on this authority is set forth in Council Rule No. 50. The timeframe for this process will be as follows:

- This memorandum shall constitute notice to all members of the Metropolitan Council of two vacancies.
- Members of the Council will be called upon to make nominations at the regular Council meeting on October 1, 2024, to fill the vacancies.
- Nominees will be notified to meet with the Council's Rules, Confirmations, and Public Elections
 Committee on Tuesday, October 15, 2024. Any nominee who does not appear before the Rules
 Committee on October 15, 2024 shall be deemed to have withdrawn their name from nomination.
- An election to fill the vacancies will be conducted at the November 7, 2024 Council meeting. It is not required for the nominee to be present on the evening of the election, but they are very welcome.
