OF CONTRACT 72654**

This Amendment is made and entered by and between the State of Tennessee, Department of Commerce and Insurance, hereinafter referred to as the "State" and Metro Nashville Fire Department, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor." For good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, it is mutually understood and agreed by and between said, undersigned contracting parties that the subject contract is hereby amended as follows:

1. Contract Section B. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

B. TERM OF CONTRACT:

This Contract shall be effective for the period beginning on November 1, 2021 ("Effective Date") and ending on December 31, 2025, ("Term"). The State shall have no obligation for goods delivered or services provided by the Contractor prior to the Effective Date.

2. Contract Section E.2. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- D.2. Communications and Contacts. All instructions, notices, consents, demands, or other communications required or contemplated by this Contract shall be in writing and shall be made by certified, first class mail, return receipt requested and postage prepaid, by overnight courier service with an asset tracking system, or by email or facsimile transmission with recipient confirmation. All communications, regardless of method of transmission, shall be addressed to the respective Party at the appropriate mailing address, facsimile number, or email address as stated below or any other address provided in writing by a Party.


All instructions, notices, consents, demands, or other communications shall be considered effective upon receipt or recipient confirmation as may be required.
