# RESOLUTIONS

### 1. <u>RS2022-1694</u> (Allen)

Referred to the Budget & Finance Committee (Rhoten)

Initial resolution authorizing and providing for the issuance and sale of water and sewer revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$315,000,000 of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County.

### 2. <u>RS2022-1695</u> (Allen)

Referred to the Budget & Finance Committee (Rhoten)

Supplements and amends Substitute Resolution No. RS2010-1442 to authorize the execution, terms and delivery of a loan agreement by and between the Metropolitan Government and the United States Environmental Protection Agency, acting by and through the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to which a loan will be provided in a principal amount not to exceed \$315,000,000, providing for the financing of certain water and sewer system projects of the Metropolitan Government, and to authorize the execution, terms, issuance, sale and payment of one or more water and sewer revenue bonds in connection with and as evidence of said loan agreement; and repealing those provisions of Resolution No. RS2011-114 authorizing the issuance of subordinate lien water and sewer revenue bonds.
