On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for approval for the abandonment of approximately 200 linear feet of 12-inch public water main (DIP) and the acceptance of approximately 200 linear feet of 12-inch public water main (DIP) to serve the Century Farms development. The purpose is to lower the profile of the pipeline in the ground, requested by Metro Water, applicant, Century Farms, LLC, owner.
