On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the acceptance of a certain easement area that is for abandonment. These electrical easement rights were dedicated as a Permanent Electrical Easement (Instrument 20080107-0001693, R.O.D.C., TN) conveyed unto the Electric Power Board of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County. Requesting those easement rights to be abandoned. Requested by Metro Water, applicant, YMCA OF Middle Tennessee, owner.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. 
