Mr. President –

I hereby move to amend Resolution No. RS2022-1507 by adding the following recitals between the existing third and fourth recitals:

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Metropolitan Council to purchase 88 Hermitage Avenue with the understanding that the Metropolitan Government will execute deed restrictions and any other encumbrances necessary to ensure that the existing structure, formerly the home of the Tennessee School for the Blind, will be preserved and rehabilitated, that affordable housing will be constructed on the site, and that a greenway easement and community greenspace will be preserved on the property; and

WHEREAS, further, the Metropolitan Council desires that any future proceeds from the sale or lease of this property be used to address the backlog of deferred maintenance in parks operated by the Metropolitan Department of Parks and Recreation; and
