RE: Recycling Rebate Funds for FY2023 Approval Letter

Dear Mayor Cooper:

Our Program has completed the review of your Recycling Rebate Application for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. It is our pleasure to offer you the Recycling Rebate based on the application submitted. Per the United States Census Bureau, the top five most populous counties, and the municipalities therein, within the State of Tennessee are eligible for receiving rebate funds. The Recycling Rebate Funds are directly attributed to the Recycling Equipment grant offering made to all other 90 (ninety) counties throughout the State of Tennessee.

A total of \$300,000.00 has been made available for the FY23 Recycling Rebate and is distributed amongst county in the following manner:

$$\text{Rebate} = \frac{(\text{Total Population of County})}{(\text{Total Population of Five Most Populous Counties}) \times (100\% \text{ of State Funds Allocated for Recycling Equipment Grants})}$$

As stipulated in T.C.A. §68-211-825 (b), the funds made available in the Recycling Rebate shall be allocated for “recycling purposes” which may include but are not necessarily limited to recycling equipment, educational purposes, composting and organics management.

Payment requests for rebate funds may be submitted at any time during the fiscal year. Please submit all activities in the TDEC Grants Management System (GMS): https://tdec.smartsimple.com/s_Login.jsp?lang=1&prole=0.

Eligible expenses are those that are incurred from January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2023. Rebate recipients are required to provide a dollar-for-dollar match for funds requested. Matching costs will be documented at the time of reimbursement of eligible costs.

Funds for FY2023 shall not exceed **\$75,807.51**.
