#### Construction

Deck shall be a laminate of high-strength outer layers bonded to a honeycomb core of rigidity and light weight. Deck shall be a 3.2"-thick laminate composite constructed of phenolictreated cellulose honeycomb between 1/4" solid-core fir plywood. Deck edges shall be closed with a 6005-T5 aluminum extrusion that is clear-etched satin anodized. Corner reinforcement shall be made of high-impact, injection-molded poly-carbonate.

#### Corners

Deck shall attach by molded corner receptacles to most StageRight supports without tools, clamps or clips.

#### Reversible

Deck shall be finished on both sides to provide a choice of surfaces and increased wear life.






