

NOTES/Definitions:

- <u>Total LPR Camera Reads:</u> Number of times the LPR Camera reads a license plate. (Note: It is interesting to note the number of vehicles using these intersections)
- <u>Hit Notification</u>: LPR system captures image of license plate, queries law enforcement databases, and alerts MNPD that a vehicle wanted by law enforcement had been detected.
- Hit notification includes stolen vehicles, stolen license plates, missing persons, warrants, orders of protections, sex offender registry.
- <u>Verified Hit:</u> MNPD employee confirms the information to be accurate, giving authorization to conduct a vehicle stop
- Fixed and Trailer LPRs are powered by solar, and data is transmitted by cellular.
- The LPR Team monitors from 0600 hours until 2300 hours Monday-Friday.
- Assigned Officers review the hit notifications and only verify the following categories as Verified Hits
 using a dual verification process: Stolen Vehicle, Stolen License Plate, Wanted Violent Offender, and
 Missing / Endangered person.

A few examples:

An LPR hit on a vehicle taken during a carjacking led officers to the area near where it was originally taken. The vehicle was found unoccupied and recovered before it could be used in additional crimes. No suspects were taken into custody.

Received an LPR hit at Old Hickory Blvd/ Gallatin Pike N. for a stolen vehicle that was taken during a robbery. As a result of this BOLO, officers searched the air which resulted in the vehicle being located. The suspect was taken into custody and the vehicle was recovered.

Multiple LPR hits were received for a stolen vehicle around Thompson Ln at 100 Oaks Mall area. A BOLO and several updates were aired on Midtown allowing officers to arrive in the area. An officer spotted the vehicle parking at 100 Oaks mall. Suspect was taken into custody and the vehicle was recovered. The suspect has extensive Theft from Motor Vehicle and Motor Vehicle Theft history.
