Dear Metro Parks Board Members,

Friends of Warner Parks (FOWP) requests approval from the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation to accept an in-kind grant not to exceed \$3,200 to fund the purchase and installation of a Metropolitan Historical Commission (MHC) historical marker on the grounds of the 1811 House in Percy Warner Park. The 1811 House is the oldest structure in the Warner Parks and was a contributing factor in the listing of the Warner Park Historic District in the National Register of Historic Places in 1984.

At their meeting on July 17, 2023, the MHC reviewed and approved the in-kind grant and wording to be used on the marker. This text has been provided to the Metro Parks Administrative Staff in a separate communication.

The MHC works with N-DOT (formerly Public Works) to provide installation of the marker.

This request requires no match or other obligation from Metro Parks. No money will be sent to Metro Parks. All invoices will be paid for directly by Friends of Warner Parks. We are in communication with Metro Parks staff and will continue to work with them on the details of plans, materials, and schedule as the project moves forward.

Historical Marker wording approved by  
Metro Historical Commission 7/17/23:

1811 HOUSE

Built circa 1811, the Hodge House is the oldest structure in Warner Parks. In 1793 the North Carolina Assembly sold James Robertson a land grant for ten pounds. James Hodge purchased a portion of the tract in 1797. Later, this sturdy house of white ash logs was built facing the Old Trail, now known as Chickering Road. Family descendants lived here until the early 1930s when the house and 49 acres were sold to the city of Nashville. The family cemetery is on a hilltop nearby.

1811 HOUSE

This excellent example of a local two-story log farmhouse contributed to the listing of the Warner Park Historic District in the National Register of Historic Places in 1984. The structure had fallen into disrepair when Metro Parks funded a reconstruction in 2008 with support from Friends of Warner Parks. Carefully dismantled, the original logs and other materials were numbered, preserved and reused. The charming house and grounds are now available for reservation by the public.
