RE: NOTICE OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT BOARD VACANCIES

Notice is hereby given of four vacancies on the Industrial Development Board (“IDB”) of the Metropolitan Government which, pursuant to state law, is to be filled by the Metropolitan Council. Three of the vacancies are result of the expirations of the terms of three IDB members – Christina Oakley, Joshua Haston, and Mark Wright – as of September 19, 2023. One vacancy is the result of the resignation of Quin Evans Segall and will fill a partial term expiring on August 23, 2027.

Members of the IDB serve terms lasting six years. The procedure for filling vacancies on this board is set forth in Council Rule No. 50. The timeframe for this process will be as follows:

- This memorandum shall constitute notice to all members of the Metropolitan Council of four vacancies.
- Members of the Council will be called upon to make nominations at the regular Council meeting on November 7, 2023, to fill the vacancies.
- Nominees will be notified to meet with the Council’s Rules, Confirmations, and Public Elections Committee on Tuesday, November 21, 2023, and an election to fill the vacancies will be conducted at the Council meeting that evening. Any nominee who fails to appear before the Rules Committee on November 21, 2023, shall be deemed to have withdrawn his/her name from nomination.
