On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the abandonment of approximately 280 linear feet of eight-inch water main (DIP) and approximately 180 linear feet of 10-inch sanitary sewer and the acceptance of approximately 280 linear feet of eight-inch water main (DIP), one fire hydrant assembly and approximately 196 linear feet of 10- inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), and three sanitary sewer manholes to serve the Madison Trinity Apartments development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
