On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request to amend Council BL2022-1094 and Proposal No. 2022M-006ES-001 for the purpose of accepting an additional 7 linear feet of sanitary sewer main, one additional sanitary sewer manhole, 113 linear feet of steel casing pipe, and to change pipe materials for sanitary sewer mains. Specific infrastructure instead now will be 172 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), 168 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), 113 linear feet of steel casing pipe, and 6 sanitary sewer manholes, to serve the Lofts at Marathon development.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.
