On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request to revise the Proposal No. 2023M-216ES-001 for the purpose of abandoning an additional 495 linear feet of 12-inch water mains, 280 linear feet of 10-inch water mains, and two additional fire hydrant assemblies. Instead, revised infrastructure quantities are now the abandonment of 1,385 linear feet of 12-inch public water mains, the abandonment of 280 linear feet of 10-inch public water mains, and the abandonment of four public fire hydrant assemblies for the revision of the BNA Concourse D Expansion project.

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.
