

AMENDMENT NO.   1    
TO  
ORDINANCE NO. BL2020-422

Mr. President –

I move to amend Ordinance No. BL2020-422 as follows:


I. By amending the third recital clause by deleting it in its entirety and substituting therefore the following:

WHEREAS, effective enforcement of county-wide emergency health orders requires the assistance of ~~various~~ employees throughout the Metropolitan Government with existing citation authority under the Metropolitan Code of Laws; and,

II. By amending Section 1 by deleting it in its entirety and substituting therefore the following:

Section 1. That Metropolitan Code § 1.24.030, is hereby amended by adding the following language to the final sentence of this section:  
"After the declaration of a state of emergency for all or a portion of Davidson County by any officer authorized to do so, the Mayor may by written order appoint the employees of any Metropolitan Government department with existing citation authority under the Metropolitan Code of Laws to assist in the enforcement of orders issued by the Chief Medical Director, including without limitation the issuance of citations for violations of such orders."
