## **ORDINANCE NO. BL2020-494**

An ordinance to amend Section 13.08.080 of the Metropolitan Code relative to the use of license plate scanners by law enforcement for the prosecution of reckless drivers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That Section 13.08.080 of the Metropolitan Code is hereby amended by adding the following underlined provision at the beginning of subsection G:

<u>G. Except as otherwise provided in subsection I. of this section,</u> it is unlawful to operate any license plate scanner installed onto or within the public right-of-way, with the exception of uses that meet each of the following requirements:

Section 2. That Section 13.08.080 of the Metropolitan Code is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection I.:

I. This section shall not apply to the use of license plate scanners by law enforcement for the sole purpose of enforcing state and local laws pertaining to reckless driving, especially for the prosecution of persons engaged in illegal drag racing activity at speeds in excess of 70 miles per hour. Further, this section shall not apply to the use of license plate scanners at mass gatherings within the right-of-way or when intersections are unlawfully shut down to accommodate drag racing activity. To the fullest extent permitted by state law, license plate data shall only be retained during the pendency of the prosecution and shall be destroyed following the final disposition of the case.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of the public requiring it.
