An ordinance to amend the Geographic Information Systems Street and Alley Centerline Map for the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, by renaming a portion of Blake Drive from Sunnywood Drive to the dead end to “Sweet Oak Court”. (Proposal Number 2021M-003SR-001).




Figure 1: Stanford Village, Sections Three to One (l to r). Source: Register of Deeds.

The original portion of Blake Drive was developed in three segments, running from north to south. The first portion of Blake Drive appears on the 2000 plat for Stanford Village, Section One, a second portion appears on the 2001 plat for Stanford Village, Section Two, and a third portion appears on the 2001 plat for Stanford Village, Section Three (Figure 1).<sup>1</sup>

The subject portion of Blake Drive appears on the 2014 plat for 2nd Addition to Sugar Valley, owned and developed by Sugar Valley, G.P. (Figure 2).<sup>2</sup> The plat shows this portion of Blake Drive with a terminus at an easement for a temporary turnaround. The turnaround was designed
