On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request to amend Council BL2021-684 and Proposal No. 2021M-010ES-001 by resolution for the purpose of phasing the Neuhoff development. As a result, Phase 1 will include the abandonment of some existing water main and fire hydrant assemblies previously unmentioned in January. Also, Phase 1 will include the acceptance of less linear feet of public water main, fewer fire hydrant assemblies, less linear feet of public sanitary sewer main, fewer sewer manholes, and easements (see sketch for details) than previously approved by Council at the April 20, 2021 meeting (MWS proj. nos. 20-SL-70 and 20-WL-35).

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval.
