## Re: Hobson Pike Townhomes Phase 1 Planning Commission Mandatory Referral #2021M-059ES-001 Council District #32 – Joy Styles, Council Member

On behalf of the Metropolitan Planning Commission, the following item, referred to the Commission as required by the Metro Charter, has been recommended for *approval* to the Metropolitan Council:

A request for the acceptance of approximately 1,051 linear feet of 6-inch water main (DIP), 4 fire hydrant assemblies, 2,151 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer mains (DIP and PVC), and 12 sanitary sewer manholes and an associated easements (see sketch for details) to serve the Hobson Pike Townhomes Phase 1 development (MWS proj. nos. 21-SL-27 and 21-WL-18).

The relevant Metro agencies (Metro Parks, Metro Public Works, Metro Water Services, Metro Emergency Communications, the Nashville Electric Service, Metro Finance – Public Property and the Metro Historical Commission) have reviewed the proposal and concur in the recommendation for approval. This request must be approved by the Metro Council to become effective. A sketch showing the location of the request is attached to this letter.
