



WHEREAS, recent events have highlighted the concern that Metro's pensioners may be at a disadvantage when given only one option for health insurance; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Employee Benefit Board should immediately consider providing at least one additional health insurance option for Metro's pensioners to ensure that the Metropolitan Government is providing the best possible health insurance for its pensioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan County Council hereby goes on record as requesting the Metropolitan Employee Benefit Board reevaluate its decision to offer a Group Medicare Advantage plan to Metropolitan Government pensioners as their only option.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
