



Section 1. That amendments one and two to the grant by and between the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Health, to provide for the prevention, surveillance, diagnosis, and treatment of HIV/AIDS and to administer a Minority AIDS Initiative program, a copy of which amendments one and two are attached hereto and incorporated herein, are hereby approved, and the Metropolitan Mayor is authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

#### Analysis

This resolution approves the first and second amendments to a grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to the Metropolitan Board of Health, previously approved by Resolution No. RS2023-2050. Amendment one corrects the end date of the grant from February 28, 2024 to February 29, 2024. Amendment two obligates partial funding for the next grant cycle of \$3,854,666 to the previous grant award of \$811,526 for a new grant total of \$4,666,192. This grant is used to provide for the prevention, surveillance, diagnosis, and treatment of HIV/AIDS and to administer a Minority AIDS Initiative program.
