WHEREAS, the United Way of Greater Nashville will celebrate its 100th anniversary on September 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan Council honor the 100th anniversary of the United Way of Greater Nashville and celebrate the organization's tremendous impact on Nashville and Davidson County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan County Council hereby goes on record as honoring the United Way of Greater Nashville on its 100th anniversary.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
