



Analysis

This resolution approves a contract between the Metropolitan Board of Health and the Martha O'Bryan Center to operate a mobile unit to provide services to current and potential Women, Infants & Children ("WIC") Program recipients.

Pursuant to the agreement, the Martha O'Bryan Center agrees to distribute information about marketing or outreach for the nutrition and family programs, provide WIC staff with adequate parking and physical space to conduct classes for current and potential WIC recipients, to provide on-site storage for program materials, and to work in full collaboration with Metro Health staff regarding print or media coverage. Metro Health agrees to restrict use of disclosure of information received from applicants, provide professional WIC staff, provide services at the hours and days mutually agreed upon, comply with all relevant rules and regulations, and be responsible for directing and supervising officers, agents, or employees in performance of this agreement.

This contract will begin on June 1, 2022 and end on May 31, 2027.
