WHEREAS, her most recent accomplishment before stepping down was establishing TRANScend Tennessee, a statewide transgender justice education and advocacy initiative; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan Council recognizes Hedy Weinberg’s many years of dedicated service to the people of Nashville and Tennessee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Council hereby goes on record as recognizing Hedy Weinberg’s service as Executive Director of the ACLU of Tennessee.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
