



WHEREAS, every other state in the Union wisely accepts this funding, which contributes greatly to the quality of education provided to students; and,

WHEREAS, to reject this funding would send our federal tax dollars to support education in every other state in the Union except for our own; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Council opposes any rejection by the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee of federal funds supporting public education across Tennessee and any other efforts to defund Metropolitan Nashville Public Schools; and,

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan Council go on record as urging the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee to continue accepting federal funding for public education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan Council respectfully requests the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee to continue accepting federal funding for public education, for the benefit of the children of Nashville, Davidson County, and Tennessee.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
