Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves a grant contract between the Metropolitan Board of Health and the Mental Health Cooperative (MHC) related to the co-response model with the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department (MNPB), also known as Nashville Partners in Care, to provide expertise and staff in emergency behavioral health care during the pilot year.

The Metropolitan Government will provide \$82,284 to the MHC. MHC will provide master's level clinicians for mental health crisis response and assign to specific police details throughout the county, as well as coordinate with relevant Metro departments like MNPB, the Metropolitan Public Health Department, and Mayor's Office.

The term of this contract is three months, commencing April 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2022.
