Analysis

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the Ryzec Building Group, LLC to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation with an estimated value of \$2,800 with no cash match required. This grant provides for two new laptops and a PlayStation video gaming system for the exclusive use of the Kirkpatrick Community Center's new library program. The purchases will be made directly by Ryzec Building Group and no money will be given to Metro Parks. This was approved by the Board of Parks and Recreation at its December 6, 2022, meeting.
