WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this Grant application be approved and submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the grant application of the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Office of Emergency Management, for an Emergency Management Performance Grant to subsidize the emergency management program for Nashville and Davidson County, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved as submitted on February 2, 2024.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

#### Analysis

This resolution approves an application for an Emergency Management Performance Grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, by and through the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency ("TEMA") to the Office of Emergency Management ("OEM"). The application requests a grant award of \$189,525.79 with required matching funds of \$189,525.79. If awarded, this grant would be used to subsidize the emergency management program for Nashville and Davidson County.
