Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves the first amendment to a grant originally approved by Resolution No. RS2021-994 from the Tennessee Department of Health to the Metropolitan Board of Health to provide the Community Health Access and Navigation in Tennessee (CHANT) Program to deliver comprehensive care coordination services to eligible families and children.

This amendment increases the grant amount by \$2,026,600, from \$1,944,100 to \$3,970,700. The end date would be extended by one year, from June 30, 2022, to June 30, 2023. The grant budget attachment would be amended accordingly.
