An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new public water main and fire hydrant assembly, for property located at 2415 Vanderbilt Place, also known as Vanderbilt Garland Hall (MWS Project No. 23-WL-271 and Proposal No. 2024M-032ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately nine linear feet of new six inch water main (DIP) and one fire hydrant assembly, for property located at 2415 Vanderbilt Place, also known as Vanderbilt Garland Hall, is needed to construct project number 23-WL-271; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2024M-032ES-001 on February 20, 2024, for the acceptance of said water main and fire hydrant assembly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to accept approximately nine linear feet of new six-inch water main (DIP) and one fire hydrant assembly, for property located at 2415 Vanderbilt Place, also known as Vanderbilt Garland Hall, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This ordinance accepts approximately nine linear feet of new six-inch water main (DIP) and one fire hydrant assembly for property located at 2415 Vanderbilt Place, also known as Vanderbilt Garland Hall.

This ordinance has been approved by the Planning Commission. Future amendments to this ordinance may be approved by resolution.

Fiscal Note: This ordinance has no cost to Metro. Donated easements have no market value according to the Department of Water Services.
