An ordinance authorizing The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County to accept new public water and sanitary sewer mains, fire hydrant assemblies, sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at 3739 Hoggett Ford Road, also known as The Reserve at Magnolia Farms (MWS Project Nos. 22-WL-95 and 22-SL-204 and Proposal No. 2023M-065ES-001).

WHEREAS, the acceptance of approximately six linear feet of new 10-inch water main (DIP), approximately 1,014 linear feet of new eight-inch water main (DIP), approximately 220 linear feet of new six-inch water main (DIP), approximately 434 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), approximately 859 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), approximately 859 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), two fire hydrant assemblies, seven sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at 3739 Hoggett Ford Road, also known as The Reserve at Magnolia Farms, is needed to construct project numbers 22-WL-95 and 22-SL-204; and,

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Commission approved mandatory referral No. 2023M-065ES-001 on May 3, 2023, for the acceptance of said water and sanitary sewer mains, fire hydrant assemblies, sanitary sewer manholes and easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to accept

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approximately six linear feet of new 10-inch water main (DIP), approximately 1,014 linear feet of new eightinch water main (DIP), approximately 220 linear feet of new six-inch water main (DIP), approximately 434 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (DIP), approximately 859 linear feet of new eight-inch sanitary sewer main (PVC), two fire hydrant assemblies, seven sanitary sewer manholes and easements, for property located at 3739 Hoggett Ford Road, also known as The Reserve at Magnolia Farms, as shown on Exhibit 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
