



On November 4, 2021, Sandra Marshall was walking with a tour group on Broadway when she tripped on the uneven brick sidewalk. Ms. Marshall fell to the ground, injuring her knees and hitting her head. The day after the fall, Ms. Marshall sought medical treatment and was to have no broken bones, but fluid had accumulated on her left knee. Her left leg was bandaged and she was given crutches to assist with walking. When she returned to her home in Illinois, she sought additional treatment and was diagnosed with a broken kneecap and a Meniscal tear, requiring gel injections to the knee.

The Department of Law recommends settlement of this personal injury claim for \$28,000, representing \$14,029.48 in medical expenses and \$13,970.52 in pain and suffering.

*Fiscal Note: This \$28,000.00 settlement would be the 30<sup>th</sup> payment from the Self-Insured Liability Fund in FY22 for a cumulative total of \$1,312,315. The fund balance would be \$9,887,313 after this payment.*
