



NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County is authorized to abandon approximately 8,300 linear feet of existing six inch sanitary sewer force main (DIP), to construct approximately 7,500 linear feet of new 10 inch sanitary sewer force main (DIP), and to negotiate, condemn and accept temporary and permanent easements, for 13 properties located near Whites Creek Pike at Interstate 24, as shown on Exhibits 1 and 2, which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Directors of Water and Sewerage Services and Public Property Administration are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary and appropriate to carry out the abandonment, construction, negotiation, condemnation and acceptance authorized by this ordinance.

Section 3. All necessary and incidental cost of the temporary and permanent easements herein authorized to be accepted shall be paid from funds authorized from Fund No. 47335 SIR/Capital Plan #131.

Section 4. Amendments to this legislation shall be approved by resolution.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This ordinance abandons approximately 8,300 linear feet of existing six-inch sanitary sewer force main (DIP), authorizes the construction of approximately 7,500 linear feet of new 10-inch sanitary sewer force main (DIP), and authorizes the negotiation, condemnation and acceptance of temporary and permanent easements for 13 properties located near Whites Creek Pike at Interstate 24.

This ordinance has been approved by the Planning Commission. Future amendments to this ordinance may be approved by resolution.

*Fiscal Note: This ordinance has no cost to Metro. Donated easements have no market value according to the Department of Water Services.*
