



WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 12-9-104(a)(2)(b), authorizes The Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County to enter into intergovernmental agreements with the State of Tennessee by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County that this intergovernmental agreement be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That Amendment 2 to the Agreement between the State of Tennessee, Tennessee Department of Transportation, and the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, through the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved, and that the Metropolitan Mayor is authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. Any amendments, renewals, or extension of the terms of the agreement may be approved by resolution of the Metropolitan Council.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville & Davidson County requiring it.

#### Analysis

This resolution approves the second amendment to an agreement between the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) and the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure (NDOT), for the acceptance of work in connection with the construction of a sidewalk on Harding Place (State Route 255) - Phase 3, from Danby Drive to Nolensville Pike.

The original agreement was approved by Resolution No. RS2015-1534. The first amendment, approved by Resolution No. RS2020-513, replaced the agreement in its entirety.

The resolution under consideration approves the second amendment, which changes the completion date from March 1, 2022, to January 31, 2025. It also replaces the existing Exhibit A with an updated Exhibit A.
