



WHEREAS, these incidents come more than 60 years after the bombing of the Jewish Community Center of Nashville on March 16, 1958; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Council condemns these hateful, antisemitism events in Nashville and expresses its support for Nashville's Jewish community; and

WHEREAS, Jewish American Heritage Month is an opportunity to honor and celebrate the contributions, culture, and values of Jewish Americans in Nashville and around the United States and to remember that the power lies within each of us to rise together against hate and to see each other as fellow human beings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan County Council hereby goes on record as recognizing May 2024 as Jewish American Heritage Month.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County.
