A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Friends of Bells Bend Park to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to provide trail signs to improve visitor experience at the park.

WHEREAS, the Friends of Bells Bend Park have awarded an in-kind grant with an estimated value of \$1,494.00 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to provide trail signs to improve visitor experience at the park; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Friends of Bells Bend Park, with an estimated value of \$1,494.00, and the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to provide trail signs to improve visitor experience at the park, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the in-kind grant be appropriated to the Parks and Recreation Department.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves an in-kind grant valued at \$1,494 from the Friends of Bells Bend Park to the Metro Board of Parks and Recreation for the installation of trail signs at the park. There is no required local match for this grant.
