

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this construction be carried out on State Project No. 19045-2247-94, PIN 125526.13.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Proposal of the State of Tennessee, Department of Transportation (“TDOT”), to the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure (“NDOT”), for NDOT to agree to maintain signal and sidewalk upgrades in connection with TDOT’s pedestrian road safety construction initiative on State Route 106 (21st Avenue/Broadway) from Pierce Avenue to 19th Avenue South, attached hereto in duplicate as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved, and that the Metropolitan Mayor is authorized to execute the same.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution approves a Proposal from the Tennessee Department of Transportation (“TDOT”) to the Nashville Department of Transportation and Multimodal Infrastructure (“NDOT”) for maintenance of signal and sidewalk upgrades in connection with TDOT’s pedestrian road safety construction initiative on State Route 106 (21st Avenue/Broadway) from Pierce Avenue to 19th Avenue South.

Pursuant to the terms of this agreement, NDOT will be responsible for the maintenance of signals and sidewalks in connection with this project. TDOT will be responsible for all design, right-of-way, and construction services for this project.
