WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan Council recognize the TSU Aristocrat of Bands on their historic wins at the 65th Annual Grammy Awards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Metropolitan County Council hereby goes on record as honoring the Tennessee State University Aristocrat of Bands on its historic wins at the 65th Annual Grammy Awards. The Aristocrat of Bands took home the award for Best Roots Gospel Album for their album "The Urban Hymnal" and took home a second award for Best Spoken Word Poetry Album for their feature on J. Ivy's album "The Poet Who Sat By the Door."

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
