



WHEREAS, 220,983 citizens early voted, and 34,300 absentee ballots were received and processed by the Election Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Davidson County Election Commission successfully processed 308,325 votes for President and 300,941 U.S. Senate votes, both of which were record numbers; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the Metropolitan Council recognizes the Davidson County Election Commission, staff, and poll workers for their outstanding work in holding the 2020 Presidential election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. The Metropolitan County Council hereby goes on record as recognizing and congratulating the Davidson County Election Commission and all the poll workers for a successful 2020 Presidential Election.

Section 2. The Metropolitan Council Office is directed to prepare a copy of this Resolution to be presented to Election Coordinator Jeff Roberts and to the members of the Davidson County Election Commission.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
