

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution accepts a Project Safe Neighborhood (“PSN”) grant in an amount not to exceed \$39,925 from the Tennessee Department of Finance and Administration to the Metropolitan Nashville Police Department to reduce gun violence. No local cash match is required.

The Council approved Resolution No. RS2022-1704 at its August 16, 2022 meeting which approved an amendment to a PSN grant previously approved by RS2021-1096. However, the State of Tennessee did not execute the amendment. This resolution approves a new contract that replaces the prior amendment. This funding will be used to pay for overtime and equipment to investigate violent gun crimes. The term of this agreement begins July 1, 2022 and ends after 15 months.
