A resolution accepting a grant from the Centennial Park Conservancy to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, for installation and two years' monthly expenses for Wi-Fi at the Parthenon.

WHEREAS, the Centennial Park Conservancy has awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$35,836.00 with no cash match required to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, for installation and two years' monthly expenses for Wi-Fi at the Parthenon, a copy of which grant is attached hereto; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the grant by and between the Centennial Park Conservancy, in an amount not to exceed \$35,836.00, to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, for installation and two years' monthly expenses for Wi-Fi at the Parthenon, a copy of which grant is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the amount of this grant be appropriated to the Parks and Recreation Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution accepts a grant from the Centennial Park Conservancy to the Metropolitan Parks and Recreation Department for installation and two years' monthly expenses for Wi-Fi at the Parthenon. The grant is an amount not to exceed \$35,836 with no local cash match required. The Centennial Park Conservancy will be responsible for the future service fees beyond the first two years and any equipment maintenance expenses related to the Wi-Fi. There is no end date to the grant.
