Title: An ordinance to amend Title 17 of the Metropolitan Code of Laws, the Zoning Ordinance of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, by changing from CS and R6 to SP zoning for properties located at 4612 Nolensville Pike and Nolensville Pike (unnumbered) and a portion of property located at 4608 Nolensville Pike, approximately 235 feet east of Taylor Road, (7.15 acres), and located within a Corridor Design Overlay District, to permit 180 multi-family residential units, all of which is described herein (Proposal No. 2022SP-088-001).
