A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Friends of Two Rivers Mansion to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to provide signage for Two Rivers Mansion and the 1802 House.

WHEREAS, the Friends of Two Rivers Mansion have awarded an in-kind grant with an estimated value of \$7,000.00 with no cash match required to The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to provide signage for Two Rivers Mansion and the 1802 House; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Friends of Two Rivers Mansion, with an estimated value of \$7,000.00, and The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to provide signage for Two Rivers Mansion and the 1802 House, a copy of which in-kind grant is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the signage be appropriated to the Parks and Recreation Department.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the Friends of Two Rivers Mansion to the Metro Parks and Recreation Department to provide signage for Two Rivers Mansion and the 1802 House. The in-kind grant has an estimated value of \$7,000 and no local cash match is required. This has been approved by the Metro Board of Parks and Recreation.
