A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Friends of McCabe Park in partnership with the Nashville Parks Foundation to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to provide funding for renovation and expansion of the playground, landscaping, and equipment upgrades at the McCabe Park Community Center.

WHEREAS, the Friends of McCabe Park in partnership with the Nashville Parks Foundation have awarded an in-kind grant in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to provide funding for renovation and expansion of the playground, landscaping, and equipment upgrades at the McCabe Park Community Center; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Friends of Warner Parks in partnership with the Nashville Parks Foundation, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, and the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, to provide funding for renovation and expansion of the playground, landscaping, and equipment upgrades at the McCabe Park Community Center, a copy of which in-kind grant is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the amount of this in-kind grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Nashville Parks Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the Friends of McCabe Park, in partnership with the Nashville Parks Foundation, to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation with an estimated value of \$400,000 and no local cash match required. This in-kind grant will provide for the renovation and expansion of the playground, landscaping, and equipment upgrades at the McCabe Park Community Center.

This grant was approved by the Board of Parks and Recreation at its July 11, 2023, meeting.
