

## Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County, TN

A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Joe C. Davis Foundation and the Friends of Mill Ridge Park to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, for the fabrication and installation of two signs - one at Mill Ridge Park and one at the Moore Farm at Mill Ridge Park.

WHEREAS, the Joe C. Davis Foundation and the Friends of Mill Ridge Park have awarded an in-kind grant with an estimated value of up to \$3,000 with no cash match required to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, for the fabrication and installation of two signs - one at Mill Ridge Park and one at the Moore Farm at Mill Ridge Park; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Joe C. Davis Foundation and the Friends of Mill Ridge Park, with an estimated value of up to \$3,000, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, for the fabrication and installation of two signs - one at Mill Ridge Park and one at the Moore Farm at Mill Ridge Park, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this in-kind grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

## <u>Analysis</u>

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the Joe C. Davis Foundation and the Friends of Mill Ridge Park to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation with an estimated value not to exceed \$3,000 with no cash match required. This in-kind grant will provide for fabrication and installation of two signs to recognize the contributions to Mill Ridge Park of Angela Moretti Goddard, Executive Director of Joe C. Davis Foundation. One sign will be located at Mill Ridge Park and one sign will be located at the Moore Farm at Mill Ridge Park.

This was approved by the Board of Parks and Recreation on November 7, 2023.
