A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Tennessee Tennis Association to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to help Centennial Sportsplex maintain its facilities.

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Tennis Association has awarded an in-kind grant, with an estimated value of \$10,000.00 with no cash match required, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to help Centennial Sportsplex maintain its facilities; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Tennessee Tennis Association, with an estimated value of \$10,000.00, and the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department, to help Centennial Sportsplex maintain its facilities, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the in-kind grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

### Analysis

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the Tennessee Tennis Association to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation. This grant has an estimated value of \$10,000 to help Centennial Sportsplex maintain its facilities. No local cash match related to this in-kind grant is required.
