An ordinance to authorize building material restrictions and requirements for BL2021-937, a proposed Specific Plan Zoning District located at 2100, 2105 and 2107 Buchanan Street, on either side of Buchanan Street and approximately 85 feet west of Clarksville Pike (1.12 acres) (Proposal No. 2021SP-049-001). **THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE REQUIRES CERTAIN MATERIALS TO BE RESTRICTED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS**.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the following building material restrictions and requirements as a part of BL2021-937, a proposed Specific Plan Zoning District located at 2100, 2105 and 2107 Buchanan Street, are hereby authorized:

Building facades shall be constructed of brick, brick veneer, stone, cast stone, cementitious siding, or a
material substantially similar in form and function, unless otherwise approved on detailed building
elevations included with the preliminary SP

Section 2. That this ordinance take effect immediately after its passage and such change be published in a newspaper of general circulation, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
