An ordinance to authorize building material restrictions and requirements for BL2021-991, a proposed Specific Plan Zoning District located at located at 401 A-E Williams Avenue, approximately 870 feet east of Walker Terrace (2.46 acres) (Proposal No. 2021SP-066-001). **THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE REQUIRES CERTAIN MATERIALS TO BE RESTRICTED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the following building material restrictions and requirements as a part of BL2021-991, a proposed Specific Plan Zoning District located at 401 A-E Williams Avenue, approximately 870 feet east of Walker Terrace, are hereby authorized:

Building facades shall be constructed of brick, brick veneer, stone, cast stone, cementitious siding, or a
material substantially similar in form and function, unless otherwise approved on detailed building
elevations included with the preliminary SP
