A resolution accepting an in-kind grant from the Nashville Parks Foundation, in conjunction with Sail Nashville, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, in support of painting work on the Hamilton Creek Marina clubhouse.

WHEREAS, the Nashville Parks Foundation, in conjunction with Sail Nashville, have awarded an in-kind grant, with an estimated value of \$5,600.00 with no cash match required, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, in support of painting work on the Hamilton Creek Marina clubhouse; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County that this in-kind grant be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. That the in-kind grant by and between the Nashville Parks Foundation, in conjunction with Sail Nashville, with an estimated value of \$5,600.00, to the Metropolitan Government, acting by and through the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation, in support of painting work on the Hamilton Creek Marina clubhouse, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this in-kind grant be appropriated to the Metropolitan Nashville Parks and Recreation Department based on the revenues estimated to be received and any match to be applied.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of The Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.

Analysis

This resolution accepts an in-kind grant from the Nashville Parks Foundation, in conjunction with Sail Nashville to the Metropolitan Board of Parks and Recreation. This grant has an estimated value of \$5,600 in support of painting work on the Hamilton Creek Marina clubhouse. No local cash match related to this in-kind grant is required.
